Mr. Weinrich, a teacher at the Washington Gifted School remarked, “The partnership between Washington Gifted School and CGN to work together on such similar courses, projects and activities will help enhance the quality of education for students at the school while improving skills critical to success in the workplace.” The school has requested for the Supply Chain course to be taught again in March to the next set of 8th grade students.
